What do you think of when you think of ‘light?’ Is there a certain memory you have, or a certain item that comes to mind?

Maybe you think of a certain light bulb in your house that is difficult to change when it burns out, or a beautiful sunset you saw on your honeymoon, or where you keep the flashlight handy in case the power goes out. How about the neighbor who goes a little crazy with their Christmas lights every year?

One particular light that comes to my mind is a night light. When I was a little girl, I was scared to sleep in the dark. I absolutely could not sleep without having a night light on. I never had a certain stuffed animal I had to sleep with, a certain blanket, or other security item. For me, it was my night light. And, as embarrassing as it is to admit, I slept with a night light until I went to college.

I’m not sure why I was so attached to the night light, other than the fact I’d gotten used to it and it made me feel safe and secure. It was the light of my night world.

Jesus described himself as the ‘light of the world’ in John 8:12. While there are many interpretations you could take on that statement based on your experience with light (Jesus gives us direction, Jesus protects us, Jesus shows us who we really are, Jesus created a beautiful world, etc), and many of those would be true characteristics of Jesus as revealed in the Bible, what Jesus is referring to in this passage is the fact that he is the way to eternal life. He puts it this way, “Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life.” The light of life is the opportunity to live with God in heaven forever when we die, instead of being destined for darkness.

It is tempting for us to twist who Jesus is into our own worldview, to put him in a box that makes us comfortable, or others around us more comfortable. But with a bold statement like this—Jesus takes away the comfortable option! Jesus is proclaiming clearly that there is no other way to get to God but through him. He is *the* light of the world, the fulfillment of the promises God made in the Old Testament to send one who would be the light of the nations (Isaiah 42:6).

Instead of being embarrassed that we have a personal relationship with the light of the world—Jesus—let us together celebrate that Jesus is our light, our salvation—the stronghold of our lives (Psalm 27:1)!

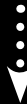
